The UCSB Police responded to South Hall on a report of a suspicious male on 10/19/09 at approximately 3:15 pm. Due to the male's behavior, the Police Department was contacted. It was reported that the male may be suicidal and in possession of a gun.

The building was evacuated and a search of the building was conducted. The male was not located. During the investigation, the identity of the male was obtained.

On 10/20/09, officers responded to calls of a suspicious male at various locations on campus. It was believed to be the same person from the incident at South Hall.

At approximately 7:20 pm, UCSB Police and a Sheriff's Deputy responded to a report of a suspicious male outside a UCSB sorority in Isla Vista. The male was identified as the male, who had been seen in South Hall. It was determined that the male had no lawful business being on the property. The male was issued a citation for Prowling. Due to the male's comments and demeanor, the Santa Barbara County Crisis & Recovery Emergency Services was contacted. The male was housed for psychiatric treatment.
