On February 8, 2008, the UCSB Police Department responded to a report of a robbery that had occurred in the Manzanita Village area. A male UCSB student was outside talking on his cell phone when two subjects approached him from the rear. Without provocation, the subjects struck the victim several times in the face and head, knocking him to the ground. Once on the ground, the victim was kicked several times in the torso by the suspects. The suspects took the victim's cell phone and fled on foot towards Isla Vista. The victim sustained moderate injuries during the assault. One of the suspects possibly injured his hand during the assault. No weapons were seen. One of the suspects is described as a white male, college age, 5'09", approx. 170 lbs. wearing a grey sweatshirt and black baseball hat.
