Computer Thefts Over Memorial Day Weekend

The UCSB Police Department is currently investigating two burglaries that occurred over the Memorial Day weekend on the UCSB Campus. The first burglary occurred at Broida Hall and resulted in the theft of two computers from an office used by graduate students from the Physics Department. The values of these computers was estimated at over \$6000.

In the second burglary, a computer was taken from an office in the Engineering III building which is currently undergoing construction. This computer was valued at over \$2000. Although there are no suspects at this time, Detectives from the UCSB Police Department are currently following up with information and evidence collected from the crime scenes.
